

Make your own Weather Chart

What you'll need

- Two pieces of stiff card
- Scissors
- Felt tip pens
- PVA Glue
- A ruler
- A paper fastener

What to do

- Divide the card into 4 equal squares
- Draw a picture into each of the squares for sunny, rainy, windy and cloudy.
- Get the children to colour in the pictures.
- Cut an arrow shape out of the second piece of card.
- Pierce the arrow with the paper fastener and place it in the middle of the chart so it can spin round and point at the different weather conditions.

You can take a few minutes each morning to talk about the weather to your minded children and get them to move the pointer each day to show what the weather is like outside.
